REQUIREMENTS

As a member of the Mid-Valley Team Penning & Gaming Association, you have a potential to qualify for a year-end award from the club. In order to qualify for a year-end award, the MVTPGA requires members to participate in working at a minimum of 50% of the events it puts on. This includes the Playday's **and** Sorting's/Team Penning's. Members are also required to attend 50% of the meetings. Meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of every month excluding January and December. In other words, you must attend at least 5 meetings during the year.

Note: There will be some exceptions, such as members who are unable to attend due to their work schedule, live more than 20 miles away, have a medical issue, etc. You will not be penalized for not attending the meetings. You must notify the club of your situation.

Members who do not meet **all** of these criteria will be disqualified from receiving their year-end award and the member who is in next place will move up a placing. Board members will make the final decision pertaining to the criteria. If you do not qualify, the board will let you know its reasoning.

Members are expected to promote a good sportsmanship-like behavior when participating, spectating, or working at the events. We all need to set good examples to our patrons. Any disputes need to be addressed to the board members rather than making a public disturbance. Any member who consistently shows unsportsmanship-like or violent behavior may be dismissed from the club. Board members will make the final decision.
